

Tabulation Process Worker

The tabulation process worker works during the evening of elections to help in the process of count the ballots. Assignments may vary from directing and checking in polling place supervisors who are bringing in ballots and election supplies to operating a ballot jogging machine or a paper-ballot vote tabulating machine. The tabulation process worker must be prompt and must work as a team member.

The number of elections varies each year, ranging from about 5 to about 15.

The pay is \$12/hour with a minimum of three hours per election.
