Deposits will be refunded to all prime bidders who return bidding documents in good condition within 10 days after the opening of bids. Bid security in the form of a bid bond (AIA Document A310) or certified check, in an amount equal to 5% of the contract sum, and payable to Washington County, Arkansas, will be required of bidders.

Performance Bond and Payment Bond (AIA Document A312), equal to the amount of the contract sum, will be required of bidder awarded the contract.

Bidders must comply with regulatory and licensing requirements of the State of Arkansas and other applicable Arkansas statutes.

This project is subject to Arkansas Prevailing Wage Rate law. Not less than the prevailing hour rate shall be paid to all workers performing work on this project.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the bid opening.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive formalities. The Owner's intent is to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
