Washington County Sheriff Tim Helder announced today that two teens were arrested in southwestern Washington County on drug paraphernalia charges and for shooting at a moving vehicle.

On February 2, 2009 at about 5:08 a.m. the Washington County Sheriff's Office received a report of two people driving west bound on Rheas Mill Road in the Farmington area, in a green Jeep Cherokee. The occupants of the Jeep reportedly fired 3 shots at the complainant's vehicle. Washington County deputies, assisted by Lincoln and Prairie Grove police, arrested Kevin Eric **DOBBS** W/M, 19 of Stillwell, OK and Miranda Lee **GONZALES** W/F, 19 of Alma, AR during a traffic stop in Prairie Grove. Deputies seized a .32 caliber revolver from the Jeep along with a pipe and syringes used for ingesting methamphetamine. No injuries were reported.

Mr. **DOBBS** was charged with committing a **TERRORISTIC ACT and POSSESSION of DRUG PARAPHERNALIA**. Ms. **GONZALES** was charged as an **ACCOMPLICE**.
