Washington County Sheriff Tim Helder announced today preliminary results regarding cause of death in the fatality fire, which occurred in eastern Washington County, have been received.

The Washington County Sheriff's Office has received the preliminary report from the Arkansas State Crime Lab regarding the cause of death of the two victims in the fatality fire at 4637 Mission Boulevard (Highway 45 E.) on February 1, 2009. The preliminary report states both boys, Forrest Daniel **TURNER**, W/M, (15) of Fayetteville, and Beau Allen **SPENCER**, W/M, (16) of Fayetteville, died of **SMOKE and SOOT INHALATION**.

The Sheriff's Office doesn't expect to receive any further results from the Arkansas State Crime Lab regarding the cause of the fire for at least a few months. A news release will be issued regarding the cause of the fire as soon as the information is made available from the Arkansas State Crime Lab.
